

HOKI ORA ATU TĪTĪ / FLY SAFE - HUTTON'S SHEARWATER RESCUE LOG

If you find a bird (dead or alive):

- Collect and keep safe in a cardboard box (do NOT warm it up!) and drop off at Hutton's Hub (Department of Conservation, 115 Ludstone Road).
- Follow instructions at the Hub.
- Record information on date/time, recovery location and weather conditions in the log below.

Log NOTES:

- Fill in a separate row for each bird or recovery location.
- For Street ADDRESS please record closest HOUSE NUMBER.
- Found WHERE? E.g. on road, lawn, under bush, etc. and whether it was in a light or dark area?
- TYPE of LIGHT SOURCE can be: street light/car park/shops/private home/motel/industrial. If possible describe colour (e.g. white, yellow, orange).
- WEATHER: If possible, also define wind direction (N/E/S/W) and strength (strong/medium/low).
- COMMENTS could include: ACTION taken, e.g. if not delivered to Hub; and anything else you think important
